Response:

The Ideal Institute of Technology established its Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in June 2019 to enhance institutional quality continuously. Before this, the College Academic Committee (CAC) focused on several key objectives, including ongoing improvement in operations, ensuring quality for all stakeholders, developing strategic action plans for academic and administrative performance, and implementing best practices.

The IQAC undertakes various functions such as gathering feedback from stakeholders, raising awareness about quality standards, documenting initiatives for quality enhancement, and organizing workshops for faculty and students.
