6.5.1 Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has contributed significantly for institutionalizing the quality assurance strategies and processes

Response:

The Ideal Institute of Technology established its Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in June 2019 to foster continuous improvement in institutional quality. Prior to this, the College Academic Committee (CAC) worked on several key objectives, such as enhancing operations, ensuring quality for all stakeholders, developing strategic action plans for academic and administrative performance, and implementing best practices.

IQAC plays a pivotal role in gathering feedback from stakeholders, raising awareness about quality standards, documenting quality enhancement initiatives, and also promotes pedagogical advancements to meet the changing needs of students and industry.

A major initiative has been institutionalization of online certification courses, encouraging faculty and students to enroll in programs from platforms like NPTEL and Coursera to broaden their knowledge. Infrastructure improvements include the establishment of online exam centers for certification tests, the expansion of library resources, and creation of new classrooms and laboratories. Introduction of "smart classrooms" and a College Surveillance project, developed by students, showcase innovative approaches to learning. Additionally, enhancements to the Result Portal with advanced recognition features reflect the institution's commitment to integrating technology into education and improving student experiences.
